School Resources and Closures

Oakland Unified School District: OUSD schools will be closed to in-person instruction through the end of the 2019-20 school year. Grab and go meals will continue to be available for OUSD students or family aged 18 and under, free of charge. Multiple days' worth of food can be picked up to take home on Mondays and Thursdays, 8:00 am – 12:00 pm.

San Francisco Unified School District: All SFUSD schools are closed through the end of the school year. Free meals will continue to be available. Pickup locations will be open two days a week, but each bag will include meals for multiple days. No identification or proof of school enrollment is required, and adults will be able to pick up meals for children without a child present.

SFUSD will loan Chromebooks to students grades 3 – 12 who do not have access to a computer. New laptop pickups: for the week of April 6, pickups will take place Monday, April 6 through Wednesday, April 8 from 10:00 am until 3:00 pm based on staggered schedule and locations, to reduce crowding.
